Entry Fee includes USAC insurance and online registration surcharge. An annual (\$70) or one-day (\$10) USAC license is required (except kids race). Licenses will be available for purchase online and on race day. Race day registration opens at 9:30 AM and closes 30 minutes before each race.

RACE GUIDELINES: This is a USAC sanctioned event, all USAC rules apply. Promoter reserves the right to alter the race course or event details. Races held rain or shine. Report 10 minutes prior to the start.

Mountain bikes OK (no bar ends). Single speed = one freewheel and cog! We'll be doling out the spoils of war as the races finish, so be prepared to head to the podium after your race is completed. Stick around to heckle—ahem—cheer the other racers on! OUT OF STATE RESIDENTS ARE ENCOURAGED TO COMPETE AND ARE ELIGIBLE FOR MERCHANDISE AND CASH AWARDS, BUT ONLY AR RESIDENTS WITH AN ANNUAL LICENSE ARE ELIGIBLE FOR THE STATE CHAMPIONSHIP AWARDS (JERSEY AND MEDALS), and racers must compete per the race age/gender/cat on their license (no racing up/down).

COURSE DESCRIPTION: Mostly grass with the usual mayhem including barriers, tight switchbacks, a sandpit, and other technical goodies. Spectator-friendly!!

KIDS RACE: Bring the kids out for a fun, short race on their very own short course, with prizes for all finishers. Bringing an extra change of clothes for the kiddos is recommended!

NOVICE RACE: This is intended for folks who want to try a cross race for the first time. **Mountain bikes are very welcome** (no bar ends)!!!

FOOD: We'll have food & beverages onsite for racers and volunteers for as long it lasts after the last race.

ADDRESS/PARKING: 5191 Western Hills Avenue, Little Rock, AR 72204. There will be signs directing folks to the parking lots; you may also park on Western Hills Ave.

ACCOMODATIONS: We recommend the Holiday Inn Express, 4900 Talley Road, 501-224-2600. It is 2.7 miles from the start and right off I-430 (exit 4).

Mention AR Cyclocross to get a discounted rate of \$89 + tax (non-smoking, 2 dbl beds, suite, free breakfast).
